Tzatzarakis Manolis was born in Heraklion, Crete, Greece in 1972 and finished his studies in Chemistry department of University of Crete in 1995. He has worked as a toxicologist in the Laboratory of Toxicology of Medical School of Univ. of Crete since 1995, where he obtained his PhD in 2000. He has been working as a lecturer of Toxicology (since 2009).

His scientific research is focused on determination of pesticides and environmental pollutants in food, water and biological samples, determination of drugs or psychotropic substances in biological samples and human hair, determination of environmental pollutants and pesticides in hair, synthesis of slow release polymeric antifungals, and assessing exposure to passive and active smoking.

Tzatzarakis Manolis has published 58 original articles in peer-reviewed international journals, 2 articles in Greek journals, has authorship in 2 book chapters, 1 patent, abstract presentations in international (98) and national (40) congresses. He is a member of the Society of Greek Chemists (EEX), the Hellenic Society of Toxicology (HST), the Society of Hair Testing (SOHT) and the Hellenic Mass Spectrometry Society (2012).

He has participated in the congress organizing committees of 3th Panhellenic congress of Toxicology and Forensic Science (2002), of 45th Congress of the European Societies of Toxicology (2008) and of 1st, 3rd and 4th Russian –Hellenic Symposium-Biomaterial and Bionanomaterials (2010, 2012, 2013). He has participated in two research projects as a coordinator and in more than 10 research projects as investigator during the last 15 years.
